It includes simple steps to back up important files, examine and analyze a computer and speed up a slow computer. Also covers how to deal with freeze-ups and other problems, including balky printers and restoring lost internet access. Downloading and installing free cleanup, anti-virus and anti-malware programs will also be demonstrated and explained.

*Prerequisite: good working knowledge of Windows OS: 7, 8.1, or 10 (preferably)
