Introduction to Windows 10 Instructor – Gail Minichiello

Monday January 22nd thru February 19th - 10 AM – 12 Noon

This class will explore the features of Microsoft's new Windows 10 operating system. Windows 10 brings back the familiar Start menu with graphic tiles enhancements and introduces the multitasking Task View, shortcuts, Action Center, and your personal assistant, Cortana. This class will address the changes and help you understand and use the new concepts in Windows 10 effectively. Though this class is introductory in nature, a good working knowledge of Windows 7 or 8.1 is expected. **This class is not for computer beginners!**

Pre-requisite: experienced with the Microsoft OS (operating system) - if not Windows 10 or 8.1 at least 7. Individuals using Windows phones or tablets will also benefit from this class.

DIY: Computer System Maintenance Instructor – Les Mahru

Tuesdays January 23rd thru February 6th – 10 AM – 12 Noon

This course is intended to reduce, or prevent your frustration with your computer system and to save you costly repair bills. It includes simple steps to back up important files, examine and analyze a computer and speed up a slow computer. Also covers how to deal with freeze-ups and other problems, including balky printers and restoring lost internet access. Downloading and installing free cleanup, anti-virus and anti-malware programs will also be demonstrated and explained

Prerequisite: good working knowledge of Windows OS: 7, 8.1, or 10 (preferably)
This is not a suitable Course for computer beginners.

Using Windows 10 4 Week Instructor Jack Schnabel

Wednesdays January 24th thru February 14th 10AM - 12N

This class will help you in your everyday computer use. We will briefly talk about what is new and useful, so you'll become more comfortable with the program. We will then cover, in detail, going online – for most of the information and activities we all depend on each day. There will be special emphasis on effective and safe browsing, which includes protecting against viruses and email scams. There will be time in each session for your questions, general discussion, and frequent hands-on practice. The fourth session will be devoted to assistance, as time allows, with each attendee's questions and problems. Attendees with laptops are encouraged to bring them to this fourth session.

Prerequisite: Basic familiarity with Windows 10
